CONSTRUCTION UPDATE FROM BROOKFIELD MULTIPLEX

Over the coming months leading to Christmas, the Principal Place Residential project will be focused on main bearing piles installation, with reinforced concrete substructure following in October. Piling will require us to mobilise a BG40 piling rig, two other smaller rigs and mobiles – commencing from 17th August 2015. You will be able to see them working above hoarding lines.

Flight Club

Alphabeta Building, 2A Worship Street, London EC2A 2AH Darts has slowly become a very big thing indeed with obsessions growing over various championships. But it's not something that makes much of an appearance in modern bars – and now Flight Club is a whole bar based around the game. It's launching in the same Alphatea building that Modern Pantry just opened in. The bar itself is being designed by Russell Sage Studios – behind The Zetter, Dishoom and more – and the game is being given a technical overhaul.



There will be food and cocktails, and the people behind it have also brought in the man behind the very successful All Star Lanes and Bounce too. Opening: 26th October 2015

1 Snowden Street, Broadgate West, London, EC2A 2DQ Abdul Yaseen, who worked at the Cinnamon Club and Cinnamon Café for a decade is going it alone with this new restaurant based on the Indian Royal Court banquets. Opening: November 2015

Soho House City Hotel

Soho House do a bank job. Poultry, EC1

The old Midland Bank on Poultry, where Goldfinger was once filmed, is becoming a new hotel with restaurants and bars (including one in the vault and one on the roof) planned. This is from the people behind Soho House. A second London Cecconi's has been rumoured for the building as one of eight new restaurants. Opening: 2015 Nobu Hotel Willow Street 10-50 Willow Street, EC2



This new development from Nobu will have 143 bedrooms and a massive 5 metre high basement restaurant. The design, by industrial designer turned architect Ron Arad, looks frankly astonishing, with a sort of metal exoskeleton protruding out on one side. Opening: 2016

Gansevoort Hotel, Curtain Road

Michael Achenbaum's new hotel in the heart of Shoreditch is due for completion in 2016. The development on Curtain Road is a three minute walk from Shoreditch High Street and will feature 120 guest rooms with 7 luxury suites, a restaurant, bi-level bar, rooftop pool and lounge. Plus a 24-hour fitness centre and over 6.000 sq ft of meeting and event space. Opening: 2016
