Koya Bar has opened up in the glitzy new Bloomberg Arcade development. It's all about the udon, made in Koya's own noodle workshop. There's breakfast daily until midday, including a modified version of their now-famous bacon and egg udon. At lunch and dinner, the menus will vary but they'll be serving a tonkatsu made with aged pork loin, coated in crunchy panko crumbs and deep fried and served with cabbage and fruit miso sauce.

2 The Stage

3 Bishopsgate Goods Yard

Owned by Hammerson plc and Ballymore. 700,000 sq ft offices, 180,000 sq ft retail and 380 residential units. Delivery TBC.

Planning consent for 29 storey hotel and 100,000 sq ft office scheme. Delivery TBC.

5 Spitalfields

750,000 sq ft offices, 10 restaurants, 13 shops and covered market.

British Land plc 4.7m sq ft on 30 acres. Home to some of the worlds biggest corps. 35,000 people.

7 Liverpool Street Station

Major rail terminus. 4 tube lines and Crossrail in December 2018. Direct link to Heathrow and Canary Wharf.

CONSTRUCTION UPDATE - MULTIPLEX

Works Update

Both concrete works and façade installation are now maintaining their planned install cycle time and progressing well. The concrete frames to the lower buildings are now complete with the main tower due to be completed early in the New Year. Façade installation to Building 3 is ongoing from levels 1 to 7, with the internal fit out due to commence in the New Year.

Basement works have been completed and handed over as planned, and mechanical and electrical (M&E) plant installation is ongoing for all the individual buildings. The main 'Power On' date has also recently been achieved. The tower fit-out is continuing on numerous levels, with partitioning and ductwork up to level 21, plastering complete to level 13 and kitchens/final finishes being installed on the lower levels.
